In his session, Dr. Balajied addressed several historical misconceptions regarding the relationship between science and faith. He also emphasized the foundational role that the Judeo-Christian worldview played in the birth and growth of modern science. The session drew participation mainly from master's degree students and a few research scholars, who engaged actively by posing numerous questions. Many participants testified afterward that their doubts were clarified, and they left with renewed understanding.
